## **Registration**

- 1. Original graduation diploma, and the notarized English version if the original is not in English;
- 2. Authenticated graduation diploma by the Taiwan representative office;
- 3. Original transcript, and the notarized English version if the original is not in English;
- 4. Authenticated transcript by the Taiwan representative office;
- 5. Authenticated health certificate (Form B) by the Taiwan representative office;
- 6. Passport and a photocopy of the information page;
- 7. Resident visa and a photocopy of it with the stamp of entry to Taiwan;



8. Authenticated medical insurance by the Taiwan representative office covering 6 months after registration; alternative, you can join the group medical insurance at OIA at registration; and

9. A 2" photo taken within the last 6 months and its digital copy.
